The UFT Runners Club had 25 members compete in the 34th annual 3.5-mile JP Morgan Chase Corporate Challenge in Central Park on June 17. And while its success from last year — when the UFT women placed first, the coed team third and the men fourth — was not repeated, it was still a great success for both veteran and novice participants. “The camaraderie of running alongside fellow teachers celebrating Central Park made for a truly satisfying end-of-year event,” said UFT Runners Club Co-Chair Kevin Miller, a teacher at PS 140 in Manhattan. Not that UFTers didn’t excel. The co-ed team — composed of Brian Horneck of Bronxwood Preparatory Academy in the Bronx, Brian Cloherty of Francis Lewis HS in Queens, Arien O’Connell of the Beginning With Children Charter School in Brooklyn and [Felicia Wagner of Grover Cleveland HS in Queens](#) — placed second out of 296 teams. The men placed 35th out of 449 teams, while the women were 54th out of 363 teams. Individually, O’Connell took fifth place among women, finishing in 21 minutes and 31 seconds.
