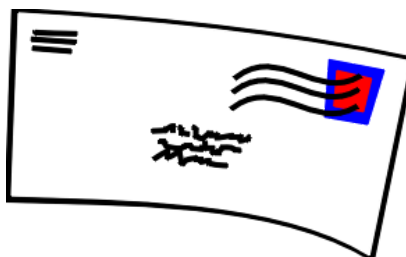

FINAL TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS

All colleges require a final transcript and verification of graduation. The College Office will mail in your official final transcript if you do the following: **Bring in a business size envelope addressed to the Admissions Office of the college you are planning to attend in the Fall. Also please attach a first class stamp to the top right hand corner of the envelope. We can not mail your envelope without a stamp. It is very important that you bring in a stamped business size envelope addressed to the Admissions Office because it insures your OFFICIAL FINAL Transcript will be sent to the college.** Be sure to write your name

and address in the upper left hand corner of the envelope. The College Office will close on June 28th and will not reopen until September. Please be aware if verification of graduation is not received by the college you risk the chance of your scheduled classes being dropped.
