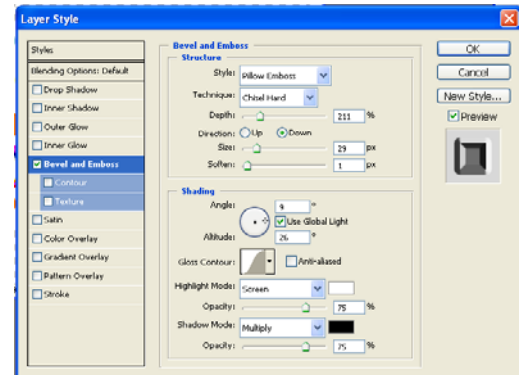


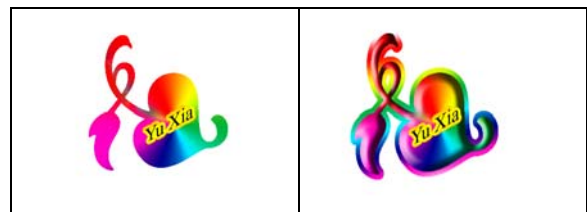
# Rollover Button

*This tutorial is not that hard once you figure how make the rollover button. The first thing I did was pretty simple. I found an image I wanted to make into a button and paste it into Photoshop. Then I added text to the image and use the blending option to make the image look better. My advice is to just play around until you like what you did. Then I save it as a jpeg. Next I make a duplicate of the image and right click on the copy image and choose blending option. I click on the bevel and emboss and I click the style to pillow emboss and then mess around with the structure and shading until I got what I like. It can come out pretty neat if you know how you want it to look like. Then I save it again in a different name, also as a jpeg. Finally copy the code and replay it with the name of my two pictures. This code goes to notepad and need to be saved as .html. I didn't know this so I have a hard time figuring out how to use the code.*
